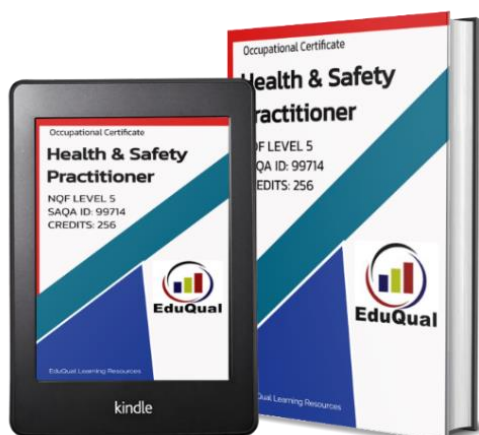

Safety, Health & Quality Practitioner

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as an Occupational Health and Safety Practitioner.

An Occupational Health and Safety Practitioner serves as a facilitator and advisor to employees and management regarding safety and health aspects in the workplace including the monitoring and inspecting of the workplace and the recording and investigation of incidents and accidents. They also implement and maintain Occupational Health and Safety systems in order to ensure a safe and healthy work environment.

Practical Skill Modules:

- Represent the needs of employees with regard to Occupational Health and Safety matters

- Inspect workplaces and environments to identify the occupational health and safety hazards and determine the risks associated with the work
- Coordinate the work activities of Occupational Health and Safety representatives
- Develop a risk profile and legal register for a designated work area
- Establish, maintain, and improve the health and safety documentation and reporting systems, controls and processes
- Advise on the establishment maintenance and improvement of emergency response and preparedness,
- Manage the effectiveness of operational Occupational Health and Safety systems
